

## Camp Rules

1. There will be no contraband, weapons, alcohol, or tobacco products at the camp.
2. There will be absolutely no stealing, fighting, or threats of any kind allowed.
3. You should not bring more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars to the camp.
4. Other than religious articles, no jewelry will be worn during camp. This includes earrings.
5. Camp members shall not leave the facility or activity location without a camp counselor escort.
6. There will be no telephone calls made without approval from a camp counselor.
7. Report any personal or medical concerns and problems to a camp counselor immediately.
8. Profanity of any type will not be tolerated.
9. Address all camp counselors and guest speakers in a courteous manner.
10. No sagging clothes; shoes are to be laced and tied. No hats, head bands, wrist bands, do rags, and other attire will be worn unless supplied by the Coalition. No clothing, which reflects gang affiliation, will be allowed.
11. Radios or walkmans are not allowed.
12. There will be no fraternization or mingling with campers from other organizations.
13. Violations of rule one (1) and two (2) are grounds for immediate expulsion. A peer review board will handle all violations.
