**“SUMMER BOY’S CAMP”
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. There will be no contraband or weapons allowed at the camp. For the purpose of the camp, contrabands are drugs or any other controlled substance. Weapons are considered any object that can be used to inflict harm upon another person. There will be no alcohol or tobacco products at the camp.
2. There will be absolutely no stealing, fighting, or threats of any kind allowed.
3. You should not bring more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars to the camp.
4. Other than religious articles, no jewelry will be worn during camp. This includes earrings.
5. You are not allowed in any unsupervised area of the campus without prior approval from a camp counselor. Camp members shall not leave the facility or activity location without a camp counselor escort.
6. Other than during evening free time there will be no telephone calls made without approval from a camp counselor.
7. You are to report any personal or medical concerns and problems to a camp counselor immediately.
8. Profanity of any type will not be tolerated.
9. All camp counselors and guest speakers are to be addressed in a courteous manner.
10. All clothing will be worn properly without any sagging, shoes are to be laced and tied. No hats, head bands, wrist bands, do rags, and other attire will be worn unless supplied by the Coalition. No clothing, which reflects gang affiliation, will be allowed.
11. Radios or walkmans are not allowed.
12. There will be no fraternization or mingling with campers from other organizations.
13. Violations of rule one (1) and two (2) are grounds for immediate expulsion from the camp. A peer review board will handle all violations.
